

2. The Defendants, as well as their agents, employees, representatives, related companies, successors in interest, and/or any persons or entities acting in concert or participating with them be and hereby are temporarily enjoined from causing or allowing to be caused the destruction or any change to Building 6 of the Oak Springs Apartments until April 14, 2017.

3. The Plaintiffs will be permitted to have their experts inspect Building 6 of the Oak Springs Apartments, subject to the following:

- a. Plaintiffs' experts must sign the waiver entered into evidence at the Temporary Injunction Hearing as Respondent's Exhibit 1; and
- b. Plaintiffs' experts will provide, at least 48 hours prior to any inspection: (1) a protocol of the inspection; (2) the identity of the expert(s) conducting the inspection; and (3) the date and time for the inspection(s).

4. Any dispute regarding an expert's protocol is to be heard by the Judge of the 150th Judicial District Court, Bexar County, Texas, on an emergency basis.

5. The general scope of the experts' inspection is: origin of the fire and electrical.

6. Any extension of this Temporary Injunction will be heard by the Judge of the 150th Judicial District Court, but not necessarily on an emergency basis.

7. The Court finds and sets the amount of the bond at \$500.00. The Court further finds and orders that the bond submitted by the Plaintiffs previously and currently in place in the amount of \$500.00 satisfies any and all bond requirements.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the trial on the merits shall be heard by the Judge of the above named Court, on October 2, 2017 at 9:00 o'clock, a.m. ~~in the courtroom of the 150th Judicial District Court of Bexar County, Texas.~~


